SPECIAL PLANTS - TRACKING LIST

- 2006 -

Approximately 3000 species of vascular plants (fern, gymnosperms, and angiosperms), and numerous non-vascular plants may be found in Mississippi. Many of these are quite common. Some, however, are known or suspected to occur in low numbers; these are designated as species of special concern, and are listed below. There are 397 special concern plants, which include 3 non-vascular plants, 27 ferns and fern allies, 4 gymnosperms, and 363 angiosperms (224 dicots and 139 monocots). An additional 86 species are designated "watch" status (see "Special Plants - Watch List") with the potential of becoming species of special concern and include 29 dicots and 57 monocots.

This list is designated for the primary purposes of : 1) in environmental assessments, "flagging" of sensitive species that may be negatively affected by proposed actions; 2) determination of protection priorities of natural areas that contain such species; and 3) determination of priorities of inventory and protection for these plants, including the proposed listing of species for federal protection.
